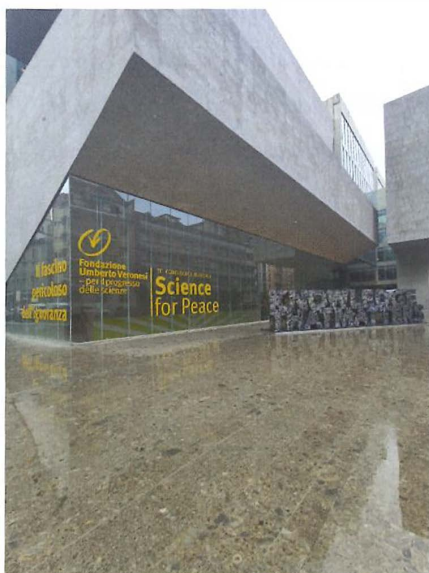




Medical education, evolving with experts
